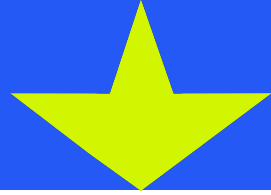

- If the child has some access requirements, will he or she be able to participate in the camp on his or her own? If not, will there be someone to assist?
- Did the child have to move due to the conflict in the East of Ukraine?
- Tell us a bit more about the child. What are his or her interests, preferences, talents?
- Is there anything else you would like to add?

#### Tab 'Motivation'

Now it is time to get to know your child.

- Please ask the child to write a few lines on why she or he wants to join the camp.
- Please ask the child to introduce, tell more about the changes he or she would like to bring to his or her environment, the motivation to join the camp and interest in the topic of ecology. This can be done in the form of an essay of 1 page maximum, video or audio of 1 minute maximum, pictures, etc. The child can choose the form he or she likes most.
