Culture and creative industries

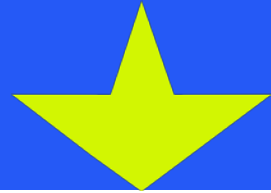

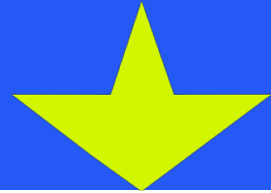
Health care and medicine

- Trainers, mentors, and university professors who work in the field of social entrepreneurship

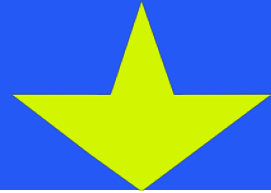
Preference will be given to the activities addressing the following topics:

¹ Social entrepreneurship is a type of entrepreneurship that simultaneously has an economic effect and measurable social impact. This means that 5-10% of income must be distributed for social aims and/or employment of socially sensitive stratum (30% of employees) and/or the main product solves a social problem.
